STEPS TO BECOME A MEMBER AT GULFPORT YACHT CLUB, INC.

Step 1: A completed application for membership shall be submitted in writing by the applicant to the Chairman of the Membership Committee (the treasurer of GYC). Please use P.O. Box if submitting money.

Step 2: The application shall be accompanied by a 1 time fee of \$100 plus 7.00 State Tax for a total of \$107.00.

Step 3: The application shall be posted to the membership for not less than ten (10) days prior to vote to become a member of the organization.

Step 4: The applicant shall attend at least one (1) General Membership meeting or may substitute a Board of Directors meeting to be considered for membership.

Step 5: Accepted member must pay all dues and fees prior to receiving a key to the club.

ASSESSMENTS:

WORK DAYS The Board will set workday dates.

A brief explanation of work days.

GYC employs no one to continually maintain the club. GYC does employ a person to mow and trim the yard. The rest of the maintenance and upkeep for the building and docks falls to the members. Thus, GYC has 4 workdays per year. If you, as a member, come out and work (usually 9 until 12), your account is credited with \$10 per workday for the following year's dues. If you do not, then the charge is used to sometimes hire outside workers or what ever is needed to keep the club maintained.

How do become a member of the Gulfport Yacht Club

Completed application for membership shall be submitted in writing by the applicant to the Chairman of the Membership Committee and shall be posted to the membership for not less than ten (10) days prior to election. Applications shall be accompanied by the required fee, and an applicant shall attend at least one (1) Board of Directors OR 1 General Membership meeting before a vote is taken on accepting applicant as member of this corporation."
